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Memorial Day Macaroni Salad

Ingredients

- 1 (16 ounce) package macaroni
- 2 red bell peppers, chopped
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 1/2 cup chopped green onions
- 1 stalk celery, chopped (optional)
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 packet dry vegetable soup mix

Directions

- Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add pasta and cook for 8 to 10 minutes, or until al dente.
- Drain, and rinse with cold water until no longer hot. Transfer noodles to a large bowl.
- Stir in red bell peppers, green bell peppers, green onions, celery and olive oil. Mix in mayonnaise and soup mix.
- Refrigerate for a few hours before serving.



Economic Outlook: Short Sales Here To Stay

The economy is beginning to show signs of a slow recovery and less shock from external forces. That being said, we still have some way to go before we can see a "full recovery" in the housing market.

Just last year, there were over a million homes listed as in foreclosure, according to *RealtyTrac*, which publishes the largest database of foreclosure, auction, and bank-owned homes in the country.

And here's where things get interesting. According to the *National Association of REALTORS*[®], of those million foreclosures, only 30 percent were listed on the market!

This means more than 700,000 homeowners may not have known their options!

If you are in an unfortunate financial position and are facing foreclosure, please know that a short sale may be a viable option.

What Is A Short Sale? Haven't You Wondered?

The property is being offered for sale at less than or "short" of the balance owed to the lender (the mortgagee).

In a "short sale" the lender *may* accept a discounted payoff and release the homeowner of the existing mortgage obligation in lieu of foreclosure. A "short sale" usually begins, but not always, when the homeowner has not been paying the mortgage payments. The two most common reasons the homeowner is not current with paying the lender are either the monthly mortgage payment grew beyond the seller's ability to pay the full monthly payment amount or the seller may have encountered a *hardship*. A hardship is where the homeowner had a personal or unforeseen situation that has prevented them from paying their mortgage payments. An example of this is the loss of an income or unexpected medical expenses. Often, in either case, the lender has started the normal foreclosure process placing the homeowner's property and credit in jeopardy.

If the homeowner is able to produce an offer to purchase the property, which makes more financial sense to the lender to accept rather than to foreclose and take back the property, this becomes an accepted "short sale". But, this may not mean the homeowner is completely free of the debt or future financial obligations.

What Should I Know As A Homeowner?

As a Real Estate Associate, I am not licensed as a lawyer nor as a CPA, and can not advise on those consequences. Except for certain conditions pursuant to the Mortgage Forgiveness Debt Relief Act of 2007, be aware that the I.R.S. could consider debt forgiveness as income, and there is no guarantee that a lender who accepts a short sale will not legally pursue a borrower for the difference between the amount owed and the amount paid. In Florida, this amount is known as a deficiency. A lawyer can determine whether your loan qualifies for a deficiency judgment or claim.
